The Grant Making Process by Chairman Louisa Gjertsen

Probably the most satisfying part of being involved with Hedge Funds Care UK is being able to give away the money raised during the year. We raised more money in 2010 than ever before and were able to fully fund three projects within, Barnardo's, Community Service Volunteers and Beatbullying.

The Grant Making Process, from the release of the Letter of Intent to the release of funds, takes approximately 6 months. The Grant Making Committee meetings and site visits are held over a period of about 1 to 2 months. This enables the charities applying for grants sufficient time to submit their proposals. The decision on how and to whom the funds are distributed to is made by the Grant Making Committee with the help of our Academic Consultant Professor Eileen Munro (of The London School of Economics).

The Grant Making Committee is made up of a Chairman and about 10 other members who have volunteered to join the Committee. We usually hold 2 or 3 meetings and make several site visits. It is not vital to attend all the site visits, but I would recommend that all committee members attend 1 site visit, as it really brings home the reason for raising the money and the benefits it can give to disadvantaged children.

The first meeting goes through all the proposals with Professor Munro, who is an expert in the child abuse field and will advise us on the projects she believes to be really worthwhile. The members of the committee then decide which charities they would like to take further through the process and arrangements are made for the site visits.

The next step is to make the site visits, or if this is not practical ask the charities to come and present to the committee at a second meeting.

The final meeting is held to finalise which charities we would like to fund and how much we are able to donate. This is the very satisfying part!

First Meeting: Wednesday 02 May at 6.00pm (venue to be arranged)
Site Visits: Monday and Tuesday 21 and 22 May
Final Meeting 22 May at 6.00pm (venue to be arranged)
